

STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW

TMCC is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion and transfer-out rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation, completion and transfer-out status of students who enrolled during the Fall 2017 semester and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed.

During the fall semester of 2017, 753 first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking students entered TMCC. After 6 years, 28% of these students had graduated from our institution or completed their programs and 11% had transferred to other higher education institutions.

While reviewing this information, please bear in mind:

- Graduation and transfer-out rates are based on 6 years of attendance that equates to 150% of our longest program.
- Graduation (and transfer-out) rates do not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government. Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
- The majority of TMCC's students are not full-time (In Fall 2024, only 29% enrolled in 12 or more units per semester), and graduation is not the only measure of success for all of our students.
